INTRODUCTION:

PASEP (People's Alliance For Social and Environmental Protection). Founded in 2011 and officially registered under Tanzania NGO Act 2002 in 2014 with Reg; No 00NGO/00006836 as a Non-governmental organization with commitment of encouraging and promoting rural community members for the sustainable and environmental Development initiatives at grassroots levels in Tanzania main land.

PASEP Exist for *"Strengthening community livelihood and sustainable utilization of natural resource with high level of productivity and production"*

PASEP Mission

"PASEP exist to empower the less privileged to sustain their livelihood and natural resource through training, advocacy, community sensitization meeting, consultancy, research and networking while making sure that awareness is raised to community on issues regarding HIV/AIDS, COVID and other Pandemic. Human right, Gender, Environmental Conservation, Sustainable agriculture and Tourism opportunities "

PASEP Objectives:

To design and implement community development projects for improved standards of living of people in both rural and urban communities;

To undertake measures that are upon environmental conservation for sustainable development, this includes renewable Energy/green Energy.

To undertake evidence and labour - based research and advocacy for responsive education and training;

To promote entrepreneurship and business management skills to both urban and rural communities in Tanzania mainland;

To strengthen and promote tourism features found in Tanzania mainland particularly at southern highland zone;

To facilitate capacity building of Civil Society Organizations;



To facilitate conflict management and resolution at work places in and between faiths-based organizations for sustainable peace;

To support community development on fighting against HIV/AIDS and Gender based violence;

Based on the above captured objectives, organization Vision and Mission, during the year 2022 PASEP in collaboration with other actors and Development Partners have managed to intervene with the Tanzania rural Community members in the following projects

1. Agroforestry and environmental protections:

During the year 2022 among the organization strategy was to promote the rural community members to plant avocado trees so as to enhance the future family economy, we managed to establish the Avocado nurseries in Njombe township and Kijyombo Village/Makete District. The established Avocado trees was sold and distributed to Mbalatse Ward, Lupila ward and other areas of Wanging'ombe and Njombe Town council.





The motive behind of this interventions is to contribute to community economical empowerment and also contributing to climate change mitigation measures by reducing the carbon emission from the atmosphere.

2. Youth Empowerment and Breaking Youth Marginalization Circle:

PASEP has managed in Cooperation with Engineers Without Borders from Berlin Germany to start establishing the Youth Mult applied skills training Camp at Kijyombo Village in Makete District.

The purpose of the Camp is to invite and enroll youth who are jobless or school drop out and having no skills for their life earnings. Youth Volunteer to join the camp and being practical trained the useful and applicable skills particularly in Horticulture, Domestic animal keeping, Beekeeping, Renewable Energy and Plumbing.

In the year 2022 we managed to construct one dormitory, one staff house and the two rooms toilet of the trainees.



In initial 18 youth have been trained on Horticulture, Renewable energy/clean Energy installations, plumbing and Domestic animals management. The training are conducted for 3Month session to 6 trainees per.





3. Establishment of Horticulture Demo Farm in Kijyombo Village, Lupila Ward, Makete District:

In the year 2022 PASEP has also managed to start/Established the Horticulture Demo Farm as Youth Farm Field School Surrounding the Mult Training Camp. The importance of the farm is to train the youth by using learning by Doing method.

The Farm is planted Avocados, Sunflowers, Beans, Bananas, Carrots, Onions, Maize and Potatoes. Most of the crops are consumed by the youth during the training because no trainee is paying for her/His studies and PASEP is still looking for Development partners for training running cost which which is the deficit of the DEMO farm productions.



PASEP and the Adult education programs are in the discussion how to work together so as the trainee to be granted the recognized certification after studies completions.
